

KUMATOO INITIATIVE GIVING VISIBILITY TO AFRICAN INVENTORS

In 2017 [Kumatoo launched a new website](#) presenting the inventions coming from African countries with information about the respective authors.

Created in 2012 and originating on the Rudy Massamba works and studies on industrial development in Africa, Kumatoo is a virtual space to bring together African inventors and to give greater visibility to their creations. Kumatoo is an officially recognized Association located in Pointe-Noire, in the Republic of the Congo.

Kumatoo's goals are to publicize African inventors and their inventions or projects and to build a Research and Development (R&D) pole in Africa that will gather the most promising African inventors. Most of the inventions presented are patented with OAPI (African Intellectual Property Organization) and have been awarded with important international prizes.

The Kumatoo catalogue include the following sections: Energy-Power, Aerospace, Robotics, Agro-processing, Solar, Writing System, Healthcare, Software, Ecology, Automotive, Electronics and Defense.

According to the founders of Kumatoo, most of these inventions could contribute in the industrialization process and respond to people's needs, valorising local materials and knowledge.
