Starting the production of the National Catalogue of Innovations in Albania

The UNDP ART Programme and the *B.A.ZH* NGO established a formal collaboration agreement to start the production of the National Catalogue of Innovations for Human Development in Albania. IDEASS activities are ongoing in Albania since many years, in strict collaboration with the United Nations programmes for territorial development, the Academy of Sciences and other institutions.

B.A.ZH is a Non-Governmental Organization which already collaborates with the IDEASS International Secretariat. In particular, *B.A.ZH* aims to promote in Albania research activities and carry out development cooperation projects in the fields of environmental protection, infrastructure, health, agriculture, food farming, processing and research, social services, education and youth development, culture, training and development planning, in order to enhance local institutions, in collaboration with local authorities, Universities, NGOs, International Organizations and other agencies.

During 2012, to start the production activities of the Catalogue of Innovations, the *B.A.ZH* NGO established a contact with two important Albanian institutions, in order to receive their inputs on the innovative technologies and methodologies for human development implemented in the country. In particular, the *B.A.ZH* NGO established collaboration with:

The Albanian Agency for Research, Technology and Innovation. The aim of this structure is to promote technology and innovation in order to establish an open and friendly society in terms of innovation capacities; enhance the important role of universities as centres of technological promotion; identify national priorities (long-term and short-term) and drafting a national plan; support of sub-financing research especially in some key areas, such as public health, agricultural production, and environmental management; so

health, agricultural production and environmental management; support research and technological development through international cooperation and support of European Union, World Bank etc.

The Academy of Sciences of Albania. The Academy, which prior the reform of the system of science and technology (2008), coordinated the Institutes and research centres of Albania, maintains its role as academic authority of great importance for all the structures that deal with science and technology in the country. In addition, the Academy has strengthened its collaboration with national scientific academies in the region and is actually member of several international scientific organisms such as: All European







Academies (ALLEA); Inter-Academic Panel (IAP); Academy of Mediterranean; European Academy of Arts; World Academy for Human Rights; Center of Studies of Countries of the Black Sea; Inter-Academic Council for South-eastern Europe.

In preliminary meetings it was suggested to establish an interinstitutional working table at the Academy of Sciences for the identification of Albanians Innovations for Human Development. The Academy of Sciences, which is also represented in the Albanian Agency for National Research, Technology and Innovation, will have an important role in inter-institutional coordination, encouraging the active participation of other important actors of the country, as the Centre for Development and Innovation of the European University of Tirana, the Technology Center of the University of Vlora, the Albanian Foundation for Local Development Capacities, the Technology Transfer Centers organized with the collaboration of different ministries.

An Albanian innovation of great interest is promoted by the IDEASS International Catalogue: *The Integrated Pest Management Package on Olive for Olive Fruit Fly Control*, by Josef Tedeschini of the Plant Protection Laboratory of the Agriculture University of Tirana.
