In Albania, the production of the National Catalogue of Innovations for Human Development is achieving important impact results, in collaboration with all the involved stakeholders.

The Albanian Agency for Research, Technology and Innovation ARTI, through a formal communication, accepted to assume the function of coordinating institution in the production of the National Catalogue of Innovations for Human Development.

The BAZH technical staff already received 18 innovations coming from different national institutions and actors involved. The proposed innovations are being evaluated using criteria agreed between the partners of the initiative.

The ongoing activities for the realization of the Catalogue are an example of excellence to identify innovations for human development in a participatory way. In particular, the activities followed these methodology steps.

The invitation to participate has been sent by BAZH NGO to more than 166 national actors: Ministers, Universities, specialized centres, territorial organizations.

Involved Albanian institutions

Numerous meetings with the institutions and other interested actors have been organized, to present the initiative, the criteria used for the identification of innovations and the submission modality of innovative technologies and methodologies. In particular, during September and October 2012, meetings have been realized in all the country. Focus groups have also been organized to meet national and local actors operating in Tirana, Shkoder, Vlora, Durres, Kruja Fushe-Kruja, Tamara, Puka, Permet, Gjirokaster, Korca, and other Albanian areas.
