

LAUNCHED THE 2014 ASHDEN INTERNATIONAL AWARD

The Ashden International Award 2014 has recently been launched for sustainable energy pioneers that are making progress in transforming people's lives through sustainable energy, saving energy, generating renewable energy or promoting behaviour change.

The annual Ashden Awards recognize organizations that are cutting carbon, reducing poverty and improving lives in the United Kingdom and developing world. The Ashden organization also supports the winners through its [international programme](#) to develop their work and to gain access to new networks.



In 2013, 14 Award winners were celebrated at the [Royal Geographical Society in London](#). Collectively, [the Ashden winners](#) have transformed the lives of around 37 million people.

Based in the United Kingdom, the Ashden organization promotes universal access to sustainable energy. In the UK Ashden promotes local sustainable energy and a shift to a low carbon economy bringing green jobs, energy security, lower fuel bills and reduced fuel poverty. Through the Awards, Ashden valorise some of the world's best green trailblazers and help them accelerate their work through the Ashden UK and International support programmes.
