ORGANIC FARMING INNOVATION AWARD ORGANIZED BY IFOAM

Every three years IFOAM Organics International, the government of the Republic of Korea and the IFOAM Technology Innovation Platform (TIPI) honour the great work of organic innovators with the Organic Farming Innovation Award (OFIA).

The deadline for the application is 31 March 2017.

The overall goal of OFIA is to contribute to solving problems and exploring potentials in order to

increase effectiveness, efficiency and productivity of organic farming, improve viability for environment, plants, animals and human beings. The objective of OFIA is to regularly highlight outstanding innovations and to incentivize organic innovations among researchers, extension agents and practitioners. By highlighting the innovations through OFIA, the global organic community emphasizes the key role innovations play to accelerate the adoption of organic agriculture worldwide.

OFIA is awarded in two categories: the Grand Prize and the Science Prize. The award ceremony is taking place during the 19th edition of the <u>Organic World Congress (OWC)</u>, November 9 -11, New Delhi, India. The award earns the winners and their inspiring work more visibility, and helps spread their messages to a wider audience.

The winners also receive a monetary award (10,000 US\$ for Grand Prize and 5,000 US\$ for Science Prize) and are granted travel and accommodation costs as well as free registration for the OWC.
