As a part of the European Commission's Culture programme, the DREAM "Design Recherche Europe Art Métiers" programme, has created an European Gallery of craft and applied art productions (www.dreamcraftgallery.eu). This gallery is an important tool for the promotion of artisans, to inform the general public, to guide the potential investors and traders at European and international level. The first productions included in this database are related to five countries (Spain, Finland, France, Italy, and Romania) and too three activity sectors. Moreover the website architecture allows adding the information on other European countries and crafts.
