

## Cuba. The CENSA celebrates the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Trial Center for the Control of the Quality of Milk and Milk Based food products and realize the International Course of Diary Labs

The National Centre for Animal and Plant Health (CENSA) of Cuba, inventor of *Stabilak* for the natural conservation of milk, celebrates the days 27 and 28 of September 2012 the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the creation of the Trial Center for the Control of the Quality of Milk and Milk Based food products (CENLAC) and the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the beginning of its relationship with the Autonomous Metropolitan Xochimilco of Mexico.

During these years, the CENSA, through CENLAC, has represented a lab of technical work for the Pan-American Federation of Dairy (FEPALE). Also in 1991 a Latin American Network of Dairy Labs was organized with the active participation of Mexico (UAM-X), Argentina (CYTIL), Chile, (Austral University) and Venezuela.

In this framework, from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 5<sup>th</sup> of October, in the head office of the CENSA in Cuba, the International Course of Diary Labs will take place, organized in collaboration with the Pan-American Federation of Diary Products. The course is aimed for Technicians of Diary Labs and food in general, specialist in sanitary regulations, control of quality of products and Staff related with the topic of organization and analysis of labs.
