SUMMER ACADEMY *RIGHT LIVELIHOOD IN TERRACED LANDSCAPES* ORGANIZED BY ITLA IN CANARY ISLANDS, SPAIN

From the 27th of April to the 5th of May 2018 the Summer Academy <u>Right Livelihood in Terraced</u> <u>Landscapes</u> will be held the in Garachico, Tenerife, Canary Islands (Spain).

The event is organised by The International Terraced Landscapes Alliance of the Canary Islands - Macaronesia (ITLA MAC) and by the Landscape Observatory of Canary Islands Government. The event is supported by the Right Livelihood College and a number of winners of the Right Livelihood Award.

The Summer Academy is a preparatory activity before the <u>IV Terraced Landscapes World</u> <u>Congress</u> organized by ITLA and to be held in March 2019 in La Gomera, Canary Islands. Focusing especially on Macaronesia area, the

new Congress will be an opportunity to share the vision of various experts on the subject and territorial experiences ongoing in the Canary Islands, Madeira, Azores, and Capo Verde.

In view of this important international event the Summer Academy *Right livelihood in Terraced Landscapes* aims at generating ideas and propositions for the recovery of the terraces of the islands, by opening new horizons through the concept of "Right livelihood" and creating new visions for the future of the insular landscapes.

The event, which is held in Spanish and English, is addresses to the ITLA members as well as academics, activists, regional and local administrations, specialists and technicians interested in the recovery of Terraced Landscapes of Tenerife and Canary Islands, with the perspective to enrich the existing views and practices.

The Summer Academy proposes a learning method through experience. The topics conceived as theoreticalpractical inputs will be communicated by recognized international specialists with experience in agro-ecology, water and soil management, architecture, geography, biodiversity. In addition, the event is focused to the study of terraces in different places of Tenerife through the application of the Participatory Action Research (IAP) methodology and the Practical Manual of Landscape (MPP).

The week program and the event's issues are presented in detail through a brochure in the <u>web site of ITLA</u>. Results of the Summer Academy will be disseminated with a book of experiences in landscape terraces of Tenerife and as supporting documentation during the IV
