

THE WINNERS OF THE 2018 FUTURE POLICY AWARD

SCALING UP AGROECOLOGY

On 15th October 2018, at FAO Headquarters in Rome (Italy) the [Winners of the Future Policy Award 2018](#) have been celebrated in a ceremony during the World Food Week.

[The 2018 Future Policy Award is dedicated to policies that scale up agroecology](#), contribute to the protection of life and livelihoods of small-scale food producers, ensure sustainable food production systems and implement climate resilient agricultural practices.

The 2018 edition of the Award has been co-organised by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), the World Future Council (WFC), IFOAM - Organics International with the support of Green Cross International, and DO-IT – Dutch Organic International Trade and Sekem Group, Egypt.

In total, 51 policies from 25 countries were presented for the Award. An international expert jury has shortlisted organic action plans, participatory programmes for urban agriculture, national policies on organic farming, and resilient municipalities with their agriculture development programmes.

The following seven [best policies promoting agro-ecological approaches have been awarded](#). These winning policies come from India, Brazil, Denmark, Ecuador, United States, Senegal, Philippines. The TEEBAgriFood initiative (The Economics of Ecosystems and Biodiversity for Agriculture and Food Evaluation Framework) has also been recognized with a *Vision Award*.
