The objectives of the course are to transfer theoretical knowledge and practical skills concerning analytical procedures and the most advanced technologies in the milk and dairy product analysis; provide basic knowledge and skills on simple methods of laboratory and field milk analysis: learn about the implementation of laboratory milk analysis quality systems through practical experiences and disseminate information on the dairy laboratories accreditation process by applying rules and procedures of good laboratory practices.

The course is aimed at dairy laboratories and food professionals and technicians, heads of quality assurance, laboratories or companies related to the dairy sector, specialists



in sanitary regulations and products quality control, personnel related to the topic of organization and laboratory analysis.

The course is structured in different activities: high-level conferences on various topics, theoretical and practical laboratory exercises (conducted by professors and technical experts), and farm level milk quality analysis applications. Upon completion of the course participants are awarded with a final diploma. The course will be held at the Testing Center for Milk Quality Control CENLAC in Havana, Cuba.
