

SECOND PAN AMERICAN MEETING OF YOUNG MILK PRODUCERS

The [Pan American Dairy Federation FEPALE](#), the Brazilian Cooperatives Organization (OCB), EMBRAPA *Gado de Leite* and the National Apprenticeship Service (SESCOOP) call young people between 18 and 30 years who are engaged in the dairy sector in the Americas to the Second Pan American Young Dairy Producers Meeting.

The event will be held in the city of Juiz de Fora (MG), Brazil, from September 15 to 17, 2015. The aim is to gather the young people linked to milk production together to exchange knowledge and experiences.

The Pan American Dairy Federation FEPALE has set the work with young dairymen as one of its strategic areas. Now, the Pan American Young Dairy Producers Meeting is held every two years. The meeting will focus issues such as the role of young dairy farmers, generational replacement, integration in milk production, farm succession, migration to cities, the participation of the young people in dairy organizations and institutions and other related.

During the three-day event, lectures, workshops, recreational, integrational and technical visits will take place. It is expected the participation of 250 participants from 12 countries, for which the meeting will have simultaneous Portuguese-Spanish translation. Places are limited.

In 2013, it has been held the 1st Pan American Young Dairy Workers Meeting in the city of *Colonia del Sacramento* in Uruguay, in which have participated 150 young people from 9 countries including Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Ecuador, Guatemala, Panama, Venezuela and Uruguay.
