

FEPALE ORGANIZES THE 3rd PAN AMERICAN MEETING OF YOUNG MILK PRODUCERS

The [Pan American Dairy Federation \(FEPALE\)](#) calls young people engaged in the dairy sector in the Americas to the 3rd Pan American Young Dairy Producers Meeting to exchange knowledge and experiences. The meeting will be held in the city of Yachay (Ecuador) from April 25th to 27th, 2017.

The event is organized in cooperation with FEPALE's members in Ecuador: the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock farming, Aquaculture and Fisheries (MAGAP); the Center for the Milky Industry (CIL); the Association of livestock farmers (AGSO); the industrial livestock farming Company *El Ordeño*; the Public Enterprise National Storage Unit (UNA EP) and the Government of the Pichincha Province.

FEPALE considers the work with young dairymen as one of its strategic areas and the Pan American Young Dairy Producers Meeting is held every two years. The meeting will focus on issues such as: the role of young dairy farmers; generational replacement; integration in milk production; farm succession planning and participation of young people in dairy organizations and institutions.

The 2nd [Pan American Meeting of Young Milk Producers](#) was held in Brazil in 2015; 200 young dairy farmers coming from 7 Latin American countries, namely: Argentina, Brazil, Ecuador, Guatemala, Panama, Uruguay and Venezuela and authorities, researchers and technicians participated in the meeting. The event was also attended by young dairy farmers coming from 12 different Brazilian States.

Lectures, workshops and field visits to get acquainted with the best experiences will take place during the 3rd Pan American Young Dairy Producers Meeting.
