

RESULTS of the 14th PAN AMERICAN DAIRY CONGRESS

More milk more health. We feed everybody

On April 29, 2016 successfully ended the 14th [Panamerican Dairy Congress](#), organized by the [Pan American Dairy Federation FEPALE](#) with the objective of generating a forum for discussion and exchange of knowledge as well as Pan-American and worldwide experiences related to the dairy sector.

The Congress hold during three days in Chile, in the City of Puerto Varas, has involved more than 700 main actors of the entire dairy sector: government officials, representatives of international and national organizations, experts, union leaders, primary producers, industry representatives, suppliers and media.

At the Congress participated 40 national and international speakers who have shared knowledge and practices in different areas of the dairy sector. At the event also have participated representatives of the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE), the Inter-American Institute for Cooperation on Agriculture (IICA).

Representatives from the Ministries of Agriculture de Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Paraguay and Uruguay, members of the Southern Agricultural Council (CAS), and the Pan-American Dairy Federation (FEPALE) signed the Declaration of Puerto Varas.

The Declaration promotes the growth of a sustainable dairy chain, from a social, environmental and productive perspective to strengthen the coordination of public and private institutional capacities in the region. It highlights that milk and dairy products are essential food for a better nutrition of human beings and are therefore included the actions undertaken by the Pan American Dairy Federation FEPALE to promote the consumption of milk and dairy products.
