

Uruguay launches the national Solar Plan

In Uruguay, the Ministry of Industry, Energy and Mining has just launched an innovative national plan (Solar Plan) that contemplates technical and financial measures to promote and exploit the use of clean and renewable energy in households by installing solar water heaters with high levels of efficiency and quality. The Solar Plan is realized jointly with other important institutions of the country such as the National Administration of Plants and Electrical Transmission (UTE), the Unit of Regulation of Water and Energy Services (URSEA), the Insurance Bank of the State of Uruguay (BSE) and the Mortgage Bank of Uruguay (BHU).

The Solar Plan is focused in its first phase for dwellings with only one family, and it will progressively broaden its proposal to buildings and cooperatives. The objective of the Solar Plan is to reach the year 2015 having as far as 50% of the Uruguayan Energetic Matrix based on renewable energy for any type of use.

This Plan also fosters national construction of the necessary equipment, providing benefits for both the producers and technicians specialized in the installation of these new technologies.
