

The result of the 2011 SEED Awards for Entrepreneurship in Sustainable Development Initiatives

The SEED Award 2011 have been awarded 35 Innovative Enterprise for Sustainable Development Initiatives from Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Egypt, Ghana, Kenya, Madagascar, Nepal, Nigeria, Rwanda, Senegal, South Africa, Sri Lanka, Tanzania, Gambia, Uganda and Zimbabwe. In addition, a special Gender Equality award was given for Solid Waste Management and Community Mobilization Programme in Nepal.

The SEED Awards is an annual awards scheme designed to find the most promising, innovative and locally led start-up social and environmental entrepreneurs in countries with developing and emerging economies.
