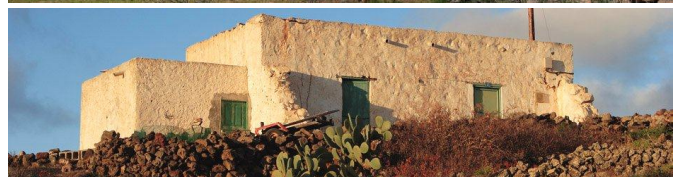
*Rincones del Atlántico* is an annual book-magazine publication, also available in digital format. All numbers are available on the *Periodicals* section of the website which disposes also of a news blog.

The aim of the journal is to disseminate knowledge, valorization and protection of the landscape and heritage, especially of rural areas, from a cultural, humanistic, ethical and constructive perspective, and offers alternatives for an efficient, eco-friendly, sound and sustainable development.

The magazine, which over the years has become an open forum for a wide range of local stakeholders, seeks to influence the content and quality of the planned initiatives carried out in the territory. To this end *Rincones del Atlántico* produced a first draft of a strategic proposal [Ideas and proposals for a better future](#) which foresees the collaboration of many local actors experts of the territory.

This powerful proposal covers issues for the primary sector (from an ownership and food security point of view), the protection of natural and cultural resources, common heritage, renewable energy, transportation and mobility, recycling and waste management, and sustainable tourism amongst others. The final document, which integrates inputs from consulted stakeholders, is an example of a proposal for an ethical, caring, eco-friendly and creative regeneration based on the development and protection of land resources and to be published in the next issue of the magazine in late 2015.

In *Rincones del Atlántico* different sections, you can find multidisciplinary contributions of different qualified local experts on topics such as traditional architecture, bio-construction, renewable energy,

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nature, agro ecology, culture, landscape. These articles can be used to support political and local development initiatives.

Since 2008 *Rincones del Atlántico* is concentrating on the production of a multidisciplinary work of great impact and high quality: *Architecture and Landscape. Traditional architecture in rural areas of the Canary Islands*. Like a comprehensive catalogue, beautifully illustrated, the book presents the traditional architecture present in all the islands where the rural landscape and vegetation play a fundamental role.

This monographic work is composed of three volumes. The [El first volume](#), published in 2008, presents the traditional housing and its immediate surroundings, viewed from the perspective of different specialties (architecture, history, geography, ethnography, rehabilitation, botany, art, literature) written by some of the best professionals in the Canary Islands in each of these areas. The second volume, published in 2014, includes information on Western Canary Islands (El Hierro, La Gomera, La Palma and Tenerife). The third and final volume of the work, dedicated to the eastern Canary Islands (Gran Canaria, Fuerteventura and Lanzarote), is under production and scheduled to be published in late 2015. This work represents an essential point of reference on the popular architecture of the Canary Islands and its natural, historical and cultural heritage.

With all these activities and results *Rincones del Atlántico* represents an exemplary initiative to promote development processes based on the optimization of natural, human, material, historical and cultural resources of the territory and the application of the latest trends for a sustainable world .
