These 15 winning enterprises were selected out of more than 300 applications. The innovative enterprises are active in the sectors of agriculture, waste management, energy, manufacturing, biodiversity conservation and tourism.

The 2017 SWITCH Africa Green (SAG) – SEED Award is sponsored by the SWITCH Africa Green project implemented by UNEP and funded by the European Union. The awards in South Africa are co-financed by the Government of Flanders.

The SAG-SEED Award winners will receive free access to supporting institutions, and tailored one-on-one advisory service that offers assistance with their business and financial plan, as well as additional marketing and promotional activities by SEED. The winners will also join a network of more than [200 enterprises from 38 countries](#) in Africa, Asia and Latin America, laureates of the SEED Awards.
