Services people need. A rationale for a fully integrated, person-centered mental health system of care

From 22 to 27 October 2012 the training second module of the Franca and Franco Basaglia International School will take place in Trieste. The course is organized in collaboration with the World Health Organization Collaborating Center for Research and Training in Mental Health, the Department of Mental Health of the *Azienda per i Servizi Sanitari n.1 Triestina*, the International Mental Health Collaborating Network IMHCN, the Friuli Venezia Giulia Region.

The general themes of the course are: working with people in crisis; planning and management of change; deinstitutionalization and community mental health systems development; devising person centered recovery plans; continuity of care, building trusting relationships; rehabilitation and habilitation of users; employment opportunities; supported housing; social and cultural programs; suicide prevention; working with families, working with people in the criminal justice system; partnerships with the community organizations and groups; managing difficult clinical situations.

On 26 and 27 October, the course will be closed by the International Conference *WHY CHANGE? Creativity and Innovation in Mental Health Development*.
