

2015 INTERNATIONAL MEETING ORGANIZED BY THE FRANCA AND FRANCO BASAGLIA INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL

From 15 to 18 December 2015 the Franca and Franco Basaglia International School will hold in Trieste the International Meeting: *A Community without exclusion: the challenge of the open door, open discourse, open access in mental health care and services through practices of freedom.*

The Meeting is organized by the World Health Organization Collaborating Center for Research and Training on Mental Health of Trieste and the Azienda per l'Assistenza Sanitaria n.1 Trieste (Friuli Venezia Giulia Region). The Meeting is also organized in collaboration with WHO Geneva and Copenhagen; International Mental Health Collaborating Network (IMHCN); COPERSAMM; UNESP (Brazil); A,Bra.S.Me; Lister (Utrecht, Netherlands); Trimbos Instituut (Netherlands); Tata Foundation Trust (India); NGO Banyan, Chennai (India); Hospital Permai, Johor Bahru (Malaysia).

The meeting is aimed at exchanging experiences and practices through a reciprocal learning process among innovators, raising awareness of the emerging needs in the field of community mental health and expanding international networks toward change. An action plan will be issued for immediate implementation.

The International Meeting program includes: Study visit to Trieste Mental Health Services; Workshops on practices of freedom and liberty; Presentations on: The alliance of Psychiatric Hospitals in transition in low and middle income countries and experiences in WHO Quality Rights; The INCENSE Program in India.
