THE ASHDEN ORGANIZATION PRESENTS THE LONGLIST OF THE 2020 AWARDS

In January 2020 the Ashden organization announced the <u>longlist of</u> the finalists for the 2020 Ashden <u>Awards</u>: 44 inspiring climate solutions from 25 countries around the world, that are tackling the climate crisis with practical action.

The Ashden Awards are inspired by the objectives of the Paris Agreement and the UN's 2030 Sustainable Development Goals and recognize organizations that are cutting carbon emissions, reducing poverty and improving lives. Winners are rewarded for their originality and impact.



The 44 finalists of the 2020 Awards edition embrace a diverse range of solutions, from food production to new models for sustainable house building, from new national programmes for connecting citizens with reliable electricity to new visions for more liveable cities. Another key trend in the list is the power of co-operatives and community groups to drive climate action.

Each of these 44 finalists is presented by Ashden by giving access to their respective website. This initiative from the organizers of the award allows to know their specific experiences and to appreciate the innovative solutions implemented. At the same time, it offers an overview of the wealth of practices underway around the world that make a contribution towards a systemic change in climate action.

Based in the United Kingdom, since 2001 the <u>Ashden organization</u> promotes universal access to sustainable energy supporting projects around the world. In the UK Ashden promotes local sustainable energy and a shift to a low carbon economy bringing green jobs, energy security, lower fuel bills and reduced fuel poverty

In April 2020 a shortlist of 22 solutions for the Ashden Awards has been selected by the Jury and the final winners will be announced and celebrated virtually on 2 July 2020.
