
The Dairy Training Institute of the <u>Pan</u> American <u>Dairy Federation FEPALE</u> organizes the International E-learning Course <u>Strategic Tools for Milk Production</u> in Grazing Systems.

The Course explores the principles and actions related to grazing milk production systems that are entirely efficient, profitable, durable and friendly with people, animals and the environment. It is directed to producers, entrepreneurs, owners of dairy farms; managers of dairy production; technical advisors; students and all persons interested to understand aspects related to grazing milk production systems.

The Course addresses issues such as the challenges inherent in organizing grazing systems with climate change, complementary crops in pastoral systems, integrated management of soil fertility and pasture production to gain efficiency in the management of grazing systems on hard soils, and other key aspects of pastures.

The Course starts on October 14, 2019 and takes place in Elearning. Each participant must allocate a maximum of 6 working hours per week to attend the 9-week program of activities.

The training activity consists of nine weekly modules that include presentations by teachers and support material in various formats, such as documents, videos and links of interest, web conferences and forums to generate an exchange of experiences. The participant will learn useful tools for the implementation of a grazing system for a quality milk production.
