

FEPALE ORGANIZES THE DISTANCE TRAINING COURSES 2020 FOR MILK PRODUCTION IN GRAZING SYSTEMS

The Dairy Training Institute of the [Pan American Dairy Federation FEPALE](#) has launched the 2020 international distance training courses for milk production in sustainable grazing systems, profitable and friendly to people, animals and the environment.

The 2020 edition includes three Training Courses:

- Course 1: [*The grazing production systems, strategies for the production and efficient use of forage. 4/5/20 – 1/6/20.*](#)
- Course 2: [*Management of nutrition and feeding in grazing systems - 10/8/20 to 7/9/20.*](#)
- Course 3: [*The cow in a grazing system: reproduction, comfort, health, performance indicators - 11/9/20 to 12/7/20.*](#)

The training courses are addressed to producers, entrepreneurs, owners of dairy farms; managers of dairy production; technical advisors; students and all persons interested in understanding those aspects related to grazing milk production systems.

Course 1 integrates the key components of milk production related to forage feeding. Forage management is presented as a key to achieve a good production, use, and conservation of pasture surpluses, as well as the use of conserved forage in periods of deficiency. Furthermore, the course includes the principles and strategic actions to be adopted to improve and maintain soil fertility in a rational and sustainable way.

The Course will start on May 4th, 2020 and will end on June 1st, 2020. The Course will take place in E-learning. Each participant should allocate a maximum of 6 working hours per week to attend the program which will consist of four weekly modules.
