

## FEPALE ORGANIZES THE 5th PAN AMERICAN MEETING OF YOUNG DAIRY FARMERS IN PARAGUAY

The Pan American Dairy Federation FEPALE calls to participate in the [5th Pan American Meeting of Young Dairy Farmers](#) to be held next October 2023 in Paraguay.

This edition of the Meeting will take place from 25 to 27 of October and it is organized by the Pan American Dairy Federation FEPALE together with the Paraguayan Chamber of Dairy Industrialists – CAPAINLAC, the Committee of Young Dairy Farmers of Paraguay of the Association of Milk Producers and Breeders of Dairy Breeds – APROLE, and with the support of the Vice Ministry of Livestock of Paraguay.

The event will take place at the SAPLE premises of the Cooperativa La Holanda in the Department of Caaguazú. The host venue will be EL DAZZLER HOTEL at km. 8 of Alto Paraná.

Since 2013 the Pan-American Dairy Federation FEPALE has defined the work with Young Dairy Farmers as one of its strategic areas and every two years it convenes the Pan-American Meetings of Young Dairy Farmers where among other related topics, issues such as the role of young milk producers, the replacement of generational change in milk production, the succession in farm management, the role of young people in incorporating new technologies, the participation of young people in dairy organizations and entities are discussed.

In 2013 the 1st Pan-American Meeting of Young Dairy Farmers was held in the city of Colonia del Sacramento, Uruguay. In 2015, the 2nd Meeting was held in Juiz de Fora, Brazil, with the participation of more than 200 young people from Argentina, Brazil, Ecuador, Guatemala, Panama, Uruguay and Venezuela



representing the dairy sector. The 3rd Meeting was held in Ecuador, in the Provinces of Pichincha and Imbabura, in April 2017, with the participation of more than 230 young people from 12 countries: Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, Guatemala, Mexico, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Uruguay and Venezuela. In 2019 the 4th Meeting was held in Panama.

Due to the pandemic, this edition in Paraguay was delayed two years and the organizers aim to bring together in Paraguay more than 300 young leaders committed to the future of the Dairy Sector in Latin America.

The Paraguayan Young Dairy Commission is organizing this event with great enthusiasm because the challenges facing milk production will be addressed from a perspective that will emphasize the vision that young farmers have.

As in previous editions, the Meeting will propose master lectures, by renowned national and foreign speakers, proficient in each topic addressed at the Meeting. During the 3 days of the event, workshops and technical visits will also be organized for the exchange of experiences, visits to the different production models in the area and social, cultural and tourist activities.
