## PANORAMA SOLUTIONS FOR A HEALTHY PLANET IN 2025 CONSERVATION AND SUSTAINABLE USE OF BIODIVERSITY

Since 2016, <u>PANORAMA Solutions</u> for a healthy planet has been identifying and promoting tested and replicable solutions in biodiversity conservation and sustainable use of natural resources. The initiative promotes their wider application through offering cross-sectoral global exchange opportunities facilitating peer-to-peer learning from successful practices.




In 2024, PANORAMA celebrated its 10-year anniversary and the impact of this initiative has grown over the years. In 2025, the PANORAMA initiative features 1606 *solutions for a healthy planet* implemented in countries of Asia, Africa, America, Oceania and Europe (compared with 1095 innovative solutions featured in 2022).

Launched in September 2016 during the IUCN World Conservation Congress, <u>PANORAMA is a joint initiative involving</u> the <u>International</u> <u>Union for Conservation of Nature IUCN, the Deutsche Gesellschaft</u> <u>fur Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ)</u> the <u>United Nations</u> <u>Development Programme UNDP</u>, the <u>United Nations Environment</u> <u>Programme UNEP</u>, the <u>World Bank Group</u>, <u>GRID-Arendal</u>, <u>Octo</u> <u>Group</u>, <u>Eco Health Alliance</u>, <u>IFOAM Organics International</u>, <u>ICOMOS</u> and <u>ICCROM</u>

The function of the PANORAMA Secretariat is currently provided by IUCN and GIZ. The initiative documents and promotes verified, replicable solutions that demonstrate how well-protected biodiversity and well-managed ecosystems help address environment, health and societal challenges and achieve development benefits.

Through its online database and digital interface PANORAMA promotes 1606 solutions across multiple, inter-linked 11 Communities. Each Community is coordinated by one or several partner organizations. The Current 11 Communities include: Restoration **Species Conservation** One Health Mitigation 30x30 Solutions Blue **Eba Solutions** Agriculture & Biodiversity **Business Engagement** Cities Nature-culture

Each solution presented in the different communities is documented to be widely shared and inspires its application in other contexts. These solutions can be entire project interventions or particular aspects of a project or approach.



PANORAMA facilitates an improved interaction between solution providers and users promoting them on a bigger scale. The initiative serves a wide variety of institutions and individuals and in 2025 connects over 1144 solution providers (791 in 2022) who represent NGOs, government institutions, academia, international organizations, foundations and the private sector, for cross-sectoral, interregional learning and knowledge exchange.

Through these activities, PANORAMA aligns with major global directives like the Kunming-Montréal Global Biodiversity Framework (GBF), the Paris Agreement, and the UN Agenda 2030, turning local and regional Solutions into global change-makers. In 2025, PANORAMA will be participating in global biodiversity events and the <u>IUCN World Conservation Congress</u> will be held in Abu Dhabi on October 9-15, 2025. As a premier platform and marketplace for biodiversity conservation knowledge, this event will provide a platform to discuss PANORAMA's methodology, share success stories, and foster new collaborations with conservation leaders from around the world. IUCN call all interested partners in participating in the Congress.

At the <u>IUCN World Conservation Congress</u> 2025 will be also announced the winners of the <u>Tech4Nature Award</u> launched at the IUCN Leaders Forum in October 2024 to fostering innovation in conservation. This award, which received its applications through the PANORAMA web platform, celebrates digital solutions for biodiversity conservation and will promote the winning innovative solutions through the initiative.

<u>PANORAMA – Solutions for a Healthy Planet</u> is a global knowledge exchange initiative and provides an open, neutral platform for anyone to share their successes, learn from the experiences of other practitioners and exchange knowledge as part of the community. The website underlines that PANORAMA is an on-going effort and invites all actors managing environmental solutions to submit a draft directly on the web platform. The <u>Manual available on the website</u> is a useful tool to know more about the criteria adopted by the initiative to identify the solutions of interest.

The solutions promoted by the PANORAMA platform can inspire the promoters of territorial and sustainable development processes to adopt the methods and approaches of greatest interest to their respective local contexts. At the same time, they can present, to the PANORAMA initiative, the projects of well-protected biodiversity and well-managed ecosystems they are carrying out in order to join a large community of knowledge exchange on issues that represent a great priority for the world.
