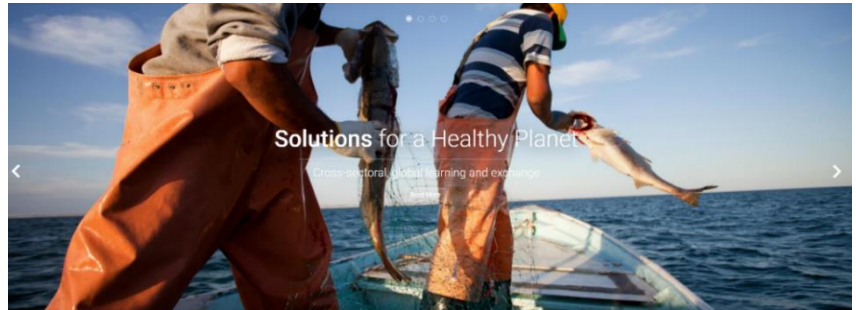


PANORAMA - PROMOTING INSPIRING AND REPLICABLE SOLUTIONS FOR A HEALTHY PLANET

Since 2016, [PANORAMA Solutions for a healthy planet](#) has been identifying and promoting tested and replicable solutions for biodiversity conservation and sustainable use of natural resources. The initiative promotes their wider application by offering cross-sectoral global exchange that facilitate learning from successful practices.



In 2026 the initiative features 1,903 *solutions for a healthy planet* now published on the PANORAMA website and implemented in more than 70 countries around the world (compared with 1,095 solutions in 2022). In August 2026, the PANORAMA initiative published an article summarizing the [impact results achieved in reaching more people, across more parts of the world, as interest in practical knowledge for conservation and sustainable development](#). In the first six months of 2026, 86 new solutions were added to the platform, building on the 177 published during 2025. Asia contributed the largest share of solutions published in 2026, with 36, followed by the Americas with 18 and Africa with 17. This geographical spread adds to the diversity of experience available through the platform, bringing together approaches shaped by different ecological, social and economic contexts. According to the organizers, the strong growth recorded in the first half of 2026 is therefore an encouraging sign of the continued relevance of PANORAMA as a global space for sharing, learning from and scaling practical solutions for people and nature.



The [PANORAMA Solutions for a Healthy Planet](#) is a multi-stakeholder knowledge management initiative designed to document, share, and scale up effective biodiversity conservation, climate, and sustainable development solutions. Launched in September 2016 during the IUCN World Conservation Congress, PANORAMA is a joint initiative coordinated by the [International Union for Conservation of Nature IUCN](#), involving diverse renowned organizations, each contributing significantly to their respective area of expertise: GIZ, UNDP, GRID-Arendal, UNEP, Rare, EcoHealth Alliance, ICCROM, World Bank Group, OCTO Group, ICOMOS, and IFOAM. Together with the individual Solution Providers from a wide range of institutions, they form the backbone of the initiative. These contributors bring a wealth of knowledge and innovative Solutions across various sectors, making PANORAMA a dynamic platform for sustainable change.



The function of the PANORAMA Secretariat is currently provided by IUCN and GIZ. The initiative documents and promotes verified, replicable solutions that demonstrate how well-protected biodiversity and well-managed ecosystems help address environmental, health, and societal challenges and achieve development benefits.

Through its online database and digital interface [PANORAMA promotes 1903 solutions across multiple, inter-linked Communities](#). Each Community is coordinated by one or more partners of the initiative.

Each solution is documented so that it can be widely shared and to inspire its application in other contexts. These solutions can be entire project interventions or particular aspects of a project or approach. PANORAMA facilitates better interaction between solution providers and users, promoting these solutions on a larger scale. The initiative serves a wide variety of institutions and individuals and currently connects over 1,330 solution providers representing NGOs, government institutions, academia, international organizations, foundations and the private sector, facilitating cross-sectoral, interregional learning and knowledge exchange

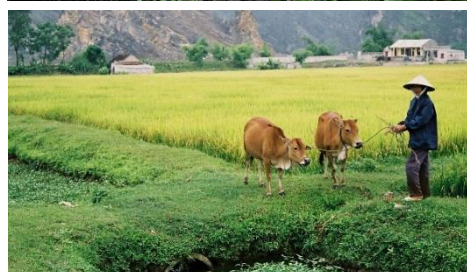
Created in 1948, the [International Union for Conservation of Nature \(IUCN\)](#) is composed of States and government agencies at the national and subnational levels, NGOs large and small, indigenous peoples' organisations, scientific and academic institutions and business associations. It draws on the experience and resources of more than 1,600 Member Organizations, as well as the expertise of more than 19,000 experts. This diversity and vast expertise make IUCN a global authority on the status of the natural world and the measures needed to safeguard it.

At the [World Conservation Congress](#) held in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates (UAE) in October 2025, and organized by the IUCN to share the vision for nature conservation for the next 20 years, the Panorama platform of innovative solutions for a healthy planet was presented to the over 10,000 attendees. The IUCN Congress, the first to host a World Summit of Indigenous Peoples and Nature, brought together decision-makers from government, civil society, Indigenous Peoples' Organisations, academia, and business for more than 1,000 events aimed at setting the conservation and sustainable development agenda for decades to come.

Panorama Solutions aligns with major global directives like the Kunming-Montréal Global Biodiversity Framework (GBF), the Paris Agreement, and the UN 2030 Agenda, turning local and regional solutions into drivers of global change.

The solutions promoted by the PANORAMA platform can inspire the promoters of territorial and sustainable development processes to adopt the methods and approaches of greatest interest to their respective local contexts. At the same time, they can present projects of well-protected biodiversity and well-managed ecosystems they are carrying out to the PANORAMA initiative, in order to join a large community of knowledge exchange on issues that are global priorities.
