

# THE LATIN-AMERICA & CARIBBEAN CLIMATE WEEK

## GRASSROOTS EXCHANGE OF KNOWLEDGE AND BEST PRACTICES

The [Latin-America & Caribbean Climate Week](#) will be hosted by the Federal Government of Brazil, from 19–23 August in the City of Salvador da Bahía. The event is the second Regional Climate Week for 2019.

[Organized within the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change](#), the Regional Climate Weeks aim at providing space for a grassroots exchange of knowledge and best practices across three regions: Africa, Latin-America and Caribbean, and Asia-Pacific.

The Regional Climate Weeks are a collaborative platform calling governments, individuals and organizations to become part of the initiatives addressing climate change in the framework of the global agreement established in Paris.

The 2019 Regional Climate Weeks will also contribute to the [Climate Summit 2019](#) hosted by the UN Secretary-General António Guterres on 23 September 2019 at the United Nations Headquarters in New York. The purpose of the Summit is to mobilize political will to raise initiatives for the achievement of the Paris Agreement goals and demonstrate how transformative actions in the real economy can support of the goals.

In the framework of the Latin-America & Caribbean Climate Week 2019, a *Knowledge Corner* is organized as an exhibition space which provides Non-Governmental Organizations, Youth Organizations and Educational Institutions with an opportunity to present their activities by advertising promotional materials in the form of flyers, leaflets, pamphlets and posters.

The exhibition space is made available by the organizers and is free of charge. The booth is offered on a rotational basis and each participant shall have the chance to exhibit materials for 4-hours (morning or afternoon) in one single day.

The *Knowledge Corner* will be a space where to valorize the various and qualified innovative solutions created in Latin-American & Caribbean countries that contribute to achieve the objectives of the global climate agreement.
