

OFIA - ORGANIC FARMING INNOVATION AWARD 2021

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

[IFOAM – Organics International](#), the South Korean [Rural Development Administration](#), and [IFOAM's Technology Innovation Platform \(TIPI\)](#) join together to honor the most outstanding organic innovators with the 2021 edition of the [Organic Farming Innovation Award \(OFIA\)](#). The Award call on the organic movement to bring attention to the work of organic innovators around the world.

The deadline for OFIA 2021 applications is April 1, 2021. The applications can be submitted in English, French, German, Spanish, Mandarin and Korean.

OFIA seeks to bring attention to organic innovations from scientists, extension agents, and practitioners around the world, contributing to solving problems and exploring the potential to increase effectiveness, efficiency, and productivity of organic farming.

The OFIA Award, in particular, invites all interested actors to submit applications that meet the following criteria:

- innovativeness: are new in their context
- applicability: are applicable to organic farming, processing and trade
- relevance: are relevant for solving real problems or exploring new potentials
- impact potential: have the potential to generate a great impact.

OFIA is awarded in two categories and its Committee will select one Grand Prize winner and one Science Prize winner based on the criteria mentioned above. The winners will receive a monetary award and will be invited to the [20th edition of the Organic World Congress \(OWC 2021\)](#) to showcase their work on 6-10 September 2021 in Rennes, France. This platform provides winners greater visibility and will help them spread their messages to a wider audience.

Through the OFIA Award, the global organic community emphasizes the key role innovations play in accelerating the adoption of organic agriculture worldwide.
