The consultation is open until the 8th of May 2019.

The inputs received by the participants will help to build the new SRIA and the team of TP Organics experts will try and integrate them where relevant. The <u>TP Organics website</u> will also present some general highlights of the feedback received in June.

The themes under consultation include:

- 1. Redesign of food and agricultural policies from local to EU level
- 2. Climate-resilient, diversified farming systems based on ecological approaches
- 3. Sustainable food systems for sustainable consumption
- 4. Research & innovation in light of the new organic regulation
- 5. Organics and emerging technologies
- 6. Topics developed together with the <u>European Public-Private</u> <u>Platform Animal Task Force</u>.

Participants can indicate their priorities for just one, several or all the themes. Also, they can indicate other relevant topics for the organic sector that should be covered additionally in the new SRIA.

The final version of TP Organics' new SRIA will be presented at the next Organic Innovation Days in November 2019 for the official launch and insightful conversations with policy-makers and innovators who are transforming our agri-food systems.
